

2025 HSC HIGHLIGHTS

Congratulations to the Class of 2025 on their strong HSC results.

Sixty-two students completed the HSC this year, achieving strong individual and collective outcomes, with Wahroonga Adventist School ranked first among NSW Adventist Schools.

Academic excellence was evident across the cohort, with 6.9% of results in Band 6 and 40.4% in Band 5, both exceeding the state average. Of the 29 subjects offered, 15 performed above the state average, highlighting the consistency and quality of teaching and learning across the School.

Almost 41% of students achieved an ATAR of 80 or above, including 19.6% who attained an ATAR of 90 or higher, reflecting sustained effort and commitment throughout their senior studies.

Creative excellence was also recognised, with three HSC ENCORE nominations for Music, celebrating outstanding performance and composition.

As the Class of 2025 steps into the next chapter, we pray that, with God's blessing, they continue to use their gifts to serve, lead and make a positive difference in their local communities and beyond.


